Fairfield Town Fee Schedule

It is the intent of this Resolution to compile all fees charged by the town, including fees for services, licenses, permits, and development applications. It is also the intent of this Resolution to repeal all resolutions or parts thereof that list any fees charged by the town, including fees not listed in this Consolidated Fee Schedule. It is not intended by this Resolution to repeal, abrogate, annul, or in any way impair or interfere with existing provisions of other resolutions, ordinances, contracts, or laws regarding penalties, bonds, insurance, fines, deposits, lease payments, Special Improvement Districts, and other monies received or paid by the town under Contract, except to effect modification of any specifically listed herein. The fees listed in this Consolidated Fee Schedule supersedes all present fees whether or not listed herein, except as excluded in the previous sentence.
